2 HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Risk Phrases : Corrosive to eyes, respiratory system and skin.
Primary route of exposure : Skin and eyes contact. Vapours inhalation.
Symptoms relating to use
 - **Inhalation** : Cough. Sore throat. Chest pain. Danger of serious damage to health by exposure through inhalation.

4 FIRST AID MEASURES

First aid measures

- Inhalation : Assure fresh air breathing. Allow the victim to rest. Inhalation of vapour can cause breathing difficulties.
Obtain medical attention.
- Skin contact : For even minor contact, immediately remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin thoroughly with mild soap and water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.
- Eye contact : In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice.
- Ingestion : Rinse mouth. Do not induce vomiting because of corrosive effects. Seek medical advice (show the label where possible).

5 FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

- Extinguishing media** : All extinguishing media can be used.
- Surrounding fires** : Use water spray to cool exposed surfaces.
- Protection against fire** : Do not enter fire area without proper protective equipment, including respiratory protection.
- Special procedures** : Exercise caution when fighting any chemical fire.

6 ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

- Personal precautions** : Spill should be handled by trained cleaning personnel properly equipped with respiratory and eye protection.
- Environmental precautions** : Prevent entry to sewers and public waters.

- Clean up methods** : Clean up any spills as soon as possible, using an absorbent material to collect it.
